Weather Summary/Alert:

Partially Cloudy weather with moderate rainfall may prevail in the upcoming 5 days with maximum temp of 27-28°C and minimum temperature of 20-21°C.

General Advisory:

In view of rains farmers are advised to drain out the excess water stagnated in fields.

SMS Advisory:

Farmers are advised to be vigilant and protect the crops in coming 2 to 3 days in view of heavy rains.

Crop Specific Advisory:

RICE	• In view of rainfall forecast farmers are advised to provide drainage channels in paddy nurseries to protect the seedlings. • In areas where paddy is at maturity to harvest stage farmers are advised to postpone the harvesting and where the crop is harvested protect the heaps with plastic sheets. • In view of heavy rainfall forecast there is a chance of occurrence of BPH after cessation of rains. To control BPH remove excess water and spray buprofigin @ 1.6 ml./L of water.
BLACK GRAM	• In view of rain forecast, In areas of excess rainfall Blackgram farmers are advised to drain the excess water. After cessation of rains, a prophylactic spray with Mancozeb@2.5g/lit of water is recommended to reduce the incidence of diseases.
GROUNDNUT	Farmers are advised to harvest the matured groundnut before germination.

TOMATO	To control Early blight disease in tomato spray mancozeb or chlorothalonil @ 2 g. or propiconazole 1 ml./L of water twice or thrice at 15 days interval.

GENERAL ADVICE	Farmers are advised to be vigilant and protect the crops in coming 2 to 3 days in view of heavy rains. 1. Remove the excess stagnated water from nurseries just transplanted paddy at tillering if excess rains received. 2. Protect the harvested produce of groundnut, maize, turmeric and pulses on the threshing floors. 3. Harvest the matured fruits and vegetables and postpone the sowing of groundnut and other pulses if excess rains received. 4. Keep the animals indoor during the period. Don't allow the animals for grazing outside. 5. Drain out the excess water in the fields as early as possible, so as to avoid rotting, seedling rot etc. 6. Avoid spraying of pesticides and application of fertilisers etc.
