### Weather Summary/Alert:

Partially cloudy weather with light rainfall may prevail in the upcoming 5 days and isolate heavy rainfall may occur on 26th & 27th with maximum temp of 27-28°C and minimum temperature of 21-22°C.

### General Advisory:

In view of heavy rains received gall midge is likely to occur in paddy. To control apply carbofuran 3g granules 10 kg./acre.

### SMS Advisory:

Tie up and harvest the top most panicles on lodged crop wherever possible and spray 5% salt solution.

RICE	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Farmers are advised to provide drainage channels in paddy nurseries to protect the seedlings. After removing excess water apply 15 kg urea and 15 kg potash per acre.</li> <li>The present weather conditions are favourable for gall midge. To control apply carbendazim 3g granules 10 kg./acre.</li> </ul>
GROUNDNUT	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>In view of rains received farmers are advised to harvest the matured groundnut before germination.</li> <li>In view of rains received farmers are advised not to take up rabi sowings in excess moisture and advised to take up rabi crops when suitable weather conditions are prevailed.</li> </ul>

After rains receded apply booster dose of urea and potash.</li> <li>• The present weather conditions are favourable for little leaf virus in Brinjal. To control remove affected plants and spray imidachloprid @ 0.3 ml/L in clear weather</li> </ul>

GENERAL ADVICE	Remove the excess stagnated water from nurseries, just transplanted paddy and crop at tillering wherever excess rains received.
