Farmers who are taking harvesting of rabi groundnut should take care that pods which are to be used for sowing purpose should be dried under sun until the moisture content is 9%.

	• Farmers who are taking up groundnut sowing under irrigation are advised to take up seed treatment compulsory. To control sucking pests treat the seed with Imidachloprid 600 F.S @ 2 ml. + 4 ml water per kg of seed.
IK II 'H	• The present weather conditions are favourable for stem rot in paddy. To control spray tilt @ 1 ml (or) tebuconazole @ 1.5 ml./L of water.
MAIZE	• The present weather conditions are favourable for fall army worm in maize and fodder maize. To control spray emamectin benzoate @ 5 SB @ 0.4 ml./L of water (or) chloranthrinilipole @ 0.4 ml./L of water by spraying directed on whorls.

CHILLI	• The present increasing temperatures are highly favourable for thrips and mite attack in chillies. To control thrips spray fepronil @ 2 ml or spinosad @ 0.25 ml or dimethoate @ 2 ml/lt. of water. To control mite spray dicophol @ 5 ml. omite @ 1 ml/lt. of water.

(COW	• In view of high temperatures in the month of April farmers are advised to keep the cattle under shade and provide good ventilation to the cattle sheds. • Hang wet gunny bags so as to provide cool weather in the cattle shed. • Provide cool water, easily digestible liquid food and silage for providing nutrient and healthy food. • Add mineral mixture, salt water and integrated and concentrated feed in equal ratio for increasing potassium and sodium levels.
