#### Weather Summary/Alert:

Cloudy weather with light to moderate rainfall may prevail in the upcoming 5 days with maximum temp of 33-34°C and minimum temperature of 23-24°C.

### **General Advisory:**

The present weather conditions are favourable for stem rot in groundnut. To control spray carbendizem @ 1 g. (or) hexaconazole @ 2 ml./L of water.

#### **SMS Advisory:**

As there is rain forecast and cloudy weather farmers are advised to protect the crop on the threshing floors with polythene sheets after harvest.

#### **Crop Specific Advisory:**

	• In late sown groundnut there is possibility of occurrence of Leaf spots and stem rot. To control spray mancozeb 400 g + carbendigem 200 g or hexaconazole 400 ml. in 200 L of water twice at an interval of 15 days.			
	• The present weather conditions are favourable for stem borer and leaf folder in paddy. To control spray Chloripyriphos @ 2.5 ml (or) Cartaphydrochloride @ 2 g/L of water.			
BLACK GRAM	• The present weather conditions are favourable for Leaf spot and powdery mildew in blackgram. To control spray mancozeb @ 2.5 g or chlorothalonil @ 2g or carbendizem @ 1 g or thiophenate methyl @ 1 g./L of water.

MANGO	• In mango anthracnose leaf spot, black band disease and gummosis are likely to occur. To control apply any copper based fungicides along with 1% bordeaux paste after pruning the stems.			
	• The present weather conditions are favourable for Leaf eating caterpillars in vegetable crops. To control spray quinolphos 2 ml. or chloripyriphos 2.5 ml. /L of water.
